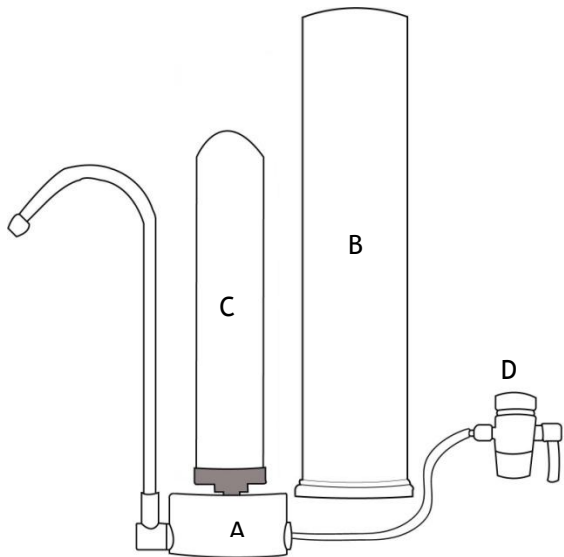

What's in the box?

- A. Stainless Steel lower housing w/ spout
- B. Stainless Steel outer housing
- C. Phoenix Spirit Cartridge w/ Activated Carbon
- D. Diverter Valve

Important

Read this user manual carefully before you use your Phoenix Countertop and save it for future reference.

Warning

- Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the water filter.
- The cartridges and accessories are designed for use with the cold supply of the mains water. Hot water may damage the filter.

Features

- The housing of the Phoenix Countertop is made of grade 304 Stainless Steel.
- The filtration system consists of a 3 stage ceramic filtration candle.
- **First Stage:** The first stage consists of the Phoenix Spirit Freedom ceramic which is manufactured to provide genuine sub micron filtration. The cartridge reduces fine particulate matter, bacteria, cysts and turbidity.

- ***Second Stage:*** The incorporation of silver locked within the ceramic structure inhibits the growth of bacteria and gives enhanced bacteriostatic and self sterilizing properties.
- ***Third Stage:*** An inner core of activated carbon block removes chlorine, VOC's and industrial solvents.
The Phoenix Spirit candle offers a lifetime of 2000 litres. The cartridge will require replacement every 6 months.

Applications

- Only use the Phoenix Water Filter to filter water that meets the drinking water standards.
- Do not use filtered water in aquariums or to water plants, it can be harmful to the fish and the plants.

Installation

Step 1:

Unscrew housing (B) from housing (A). Remove the packing material and tighten the filter cartridge (C) securely.



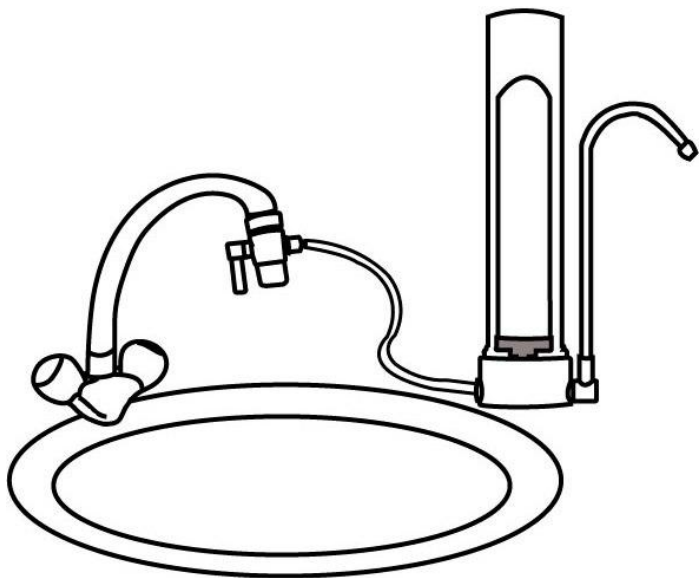
Step 2: Remove the outer fitting of your kitchen tap and remove the aerator inside.

Step 3:

Now screw the diverter valve (D) to the tap. The diverter valve comes with a built in aerator to soften the flow of water.



The diverter valve is compatible with the standard 3/8" kitchen faucet. In the case of non-standard faucets such as designer faucets, you may use the additional accessory also included in the package. The installation of the filter is now complete, hassle free.



Usage

The lever in the diverter valve can be used to select between the unfiltered water through the kitchen faucet and the filtered water, through the Phoenix Countertop.

When using brand new cartridges, it is advisable to dispose of the first 5 litres of filtered water. Doing this removes the discoloration of the water due to the unused activated carbon, as well as relieving the muddy taste of the freshly manufactured ceramic.

A reduction in the flow rate indicates the need to clean the filter. Scrub the candle under running water with a scouring pad to expose a new layer of ceramic. However, due to the activated carbon exhaustion, the Spirit cartridge is to be replaced every six months.

When not in use air-dry the spirit cartridge for a minimum of 24 hours, then store in a dry place.
